DEPARTMENT OF **ORAL MEDICINE AND RADIOLOGY**

Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology is unique in that it combines Oral Medicine and Radiology. It sits at the interface between dentistry and medicine. It is a specialist clinical area of care for treating head and neck medical diseases. Oral medicine is involved in patient care, teaching and researching involving diagnosis of orofacial complex and systematic and behavioural disorders that impact oral health. Oral Medicine and Radiology deals with the acquisition and interpretation of Radiographic imaging studies performed for diagnosis of treatment guidance for conditions affecting the maxillofacial region. In certain cases where mouth symptoms can suggest a connection with disease or problems in other parts of body and it is the oral medicine specialist who can best decide what tests or investigations are needed in these situations. Conditions managed in Oral Medicine are often chronic and may have a significant psychological, as well as physical impact on the patient's quality of life. Conservative dentistry is a branch of dentistry which is concerned with the conservation of teeth in the mouth. It embraces the practice of operative dentistry and endodontics and includes various kinds of direct and indirect restorations of individual teeth in the mouth. The primary goal of this department is prevention, diagnosis and treatment of sequelae of dental caries and the other defects of natural teeth; techniques and procedures to restore the teeth to full function and appearance in an aesthetically pleasing manner with as little loss of the healthy tooth structure as possible with periodic check-up as routine practice. The department has a state-of-the-art technology, dedicated teaching and non-teaching staff and infrastructure to render effective and predictable services to patients.

DEPARTMENT OF **PERIODONTICS**

Periodontology is a branch of dentistry that encompasses the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of diseases of supporting tissues of teeth and their artificial substitutes. Students attend dental camps and perform initial screening examinations. They are sensitised to specific needs of a variety of patient population.

DEPARTMENT OF ORAL PATHOLOGY

The Department of Oral Pathology and Microbiology is a branch of dental science that involves the study and diagnosis of diseases of mouth and jaws through the examination of exfoliated cells, surgically removed tissues (biopsy samples) and body fluids (blood and saliva) using tools of immunohistochemistry, microbiology and haematology. The department deals with teaching the subject of Dental Anatomy, Embryology and Oral Histology for the First BDS course and subject of Oral Pathology and Microbiology for Third year BDS course. The department is involved in training the post graduate students in speciality of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology and Microbiology. The staffs of the department are actively involved in academic and research activities and have many publications in the international and national journals, delivered guest lectures and presented scientific papers at various platforms.

CANCER, THE EVIL OF THE MODERN WORLD HAS CAUSED HAVOC IN TODAY'S WORLD. ACCORDING TO WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION, INDIA RANKS IN THE TOP LIST IN THE COUNT OF THE ORAL CANCERS FOLLOWED BY THE OTHER FORM OF CANCER. BEING A PART OF THE DENTAL FRATERNITY ON THE OCCASION OF WORLD CANCER DAY, 4TH FEBRUARY 2016. A MONTH LONG ORAL SCREENING CAMP WAS ORGANIZED BY NSS UNIT HEADED BY DR. ZAHEER AHMED (NSS PROGRAMME OFFICER) IN COLLABORATION WITH DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH DENTISTRY, NAVODAYA DENTAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL RAICHUR DURING JUNE - JULY 2016. ALONG WITH THE STAFFS AND THE POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS A TOTAL OF 40 INTERNS PARTICIPATED IN THIS SCREENING PROGRAMME. THE MOBILE DENTAL VAN WAS USED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION. THE TEAM OF DOCTORS VISITED TO VARIOUS URBAN AND SUB-URBAN AREAS OF THE RAICHUR CITY. DOCTORS EXAMINED THE ORAL CAVITY OF PATIENTS AND REPORTED THE VARIOUS PRECANCEROUS CHANGES IN THE ORAL MUCOSA OF THE PATIENTS. VARIOUS DEMONSTRATIONS USING AUDIO VISUAL AIDS REGARDING THE VARIOUS CAUSES OF CANCER WERE DEMONSTRATED TO THE PEOPLE WHO ATTENDED THE CAMP. HABIT BREAKING AND TOBACCO CESSATION ADVICE WAS DEMONSTRATED BY THE TRAINED DOCTORS TO THE INDIVIDUALS. PATIENTS WHO REQUIRE FURTHER TREATMENT AND PROPER ADVANCED HABIT BREAKING COUNSELLING WERE REFERRED TO NAVODAYA DENTAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL RAICHUR. NEARLY 300 PATIENTS WERE SCREENED IN THIS ONE-MONTH DURATION. THE TEAM MOTIVATED THE PATIENTS REGARDING THE LESIONS IN MOUTHS AND HOW IT COULD LEAD TO CANCER IN CERTAIN CASES. THIS PROGRAMME WAS CONDUCTED WITH A HOPE THAT WE CAN MOVE A STEP FORWARD TOWARDS A CANCER FREE SOCIETY.

NUTRITION AWARENESS PROGRAM

TO MAINTAIN HEALTH, THE HUMAN BODY NEEDS DAILY NOURISHMENT IN THE FORM OF CARBOHYDRATES, PROTEINS AND MINERALS. THE ASSOCIATIONS BETWEEN ORAL HEALTH CONDITIONS, DIETARY PRACTICES AND NUTRITIONAL STATUS, AND GENERAL HEALTH STATUS ARE COMPLEX WITH MANY INTERRELATING FACTORS. INADEQUATE NUTRITION CAN AFFECT THE ORAL HEALTH INCLUDING DENTAL CARIES, PERIODONTAL DISEASES, DISEASES OF ORALMUCOSA AND INFECTIOUS DISEASES.
